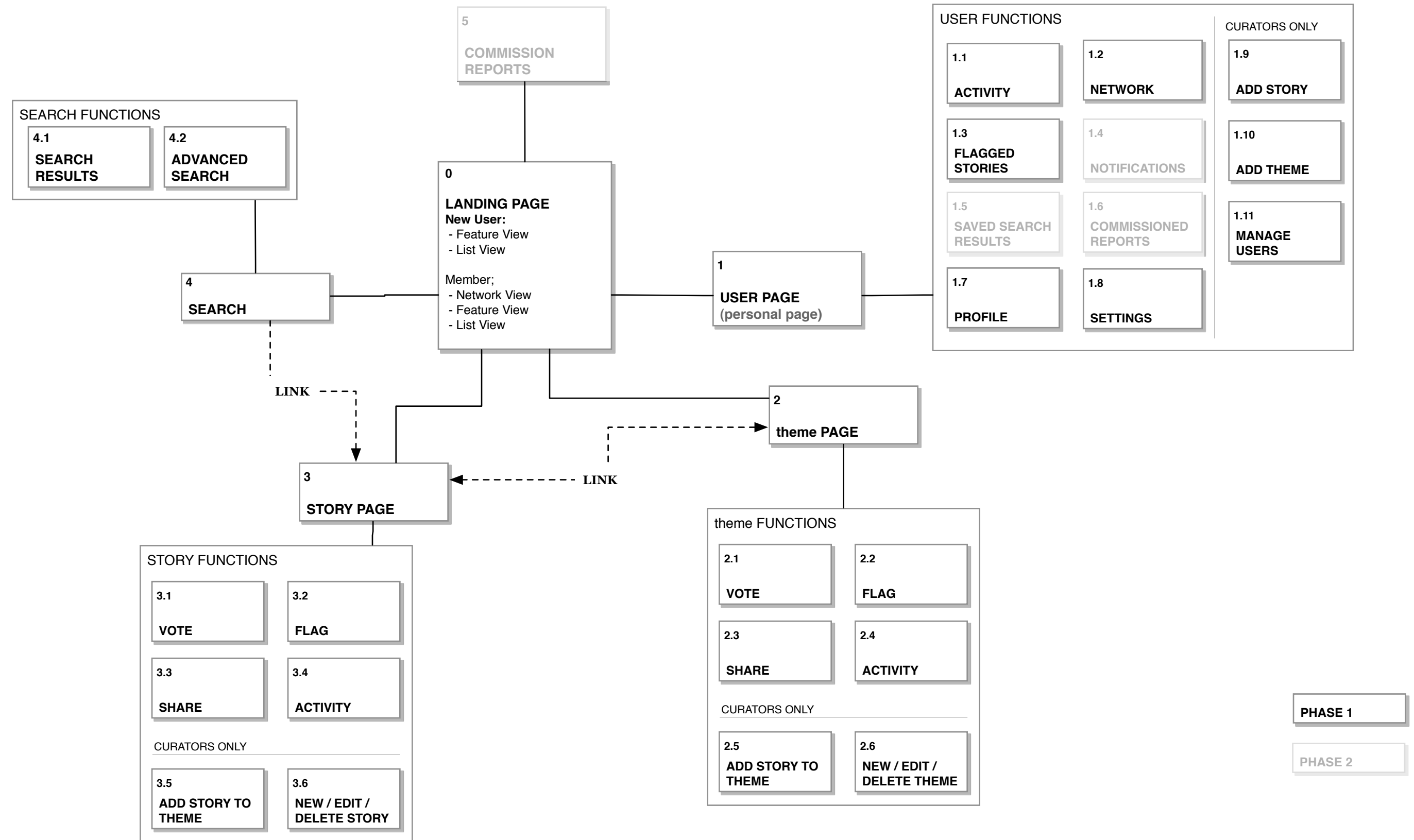


1. View Story - Voting button added to view story pages
2. List views of stories (logged in landing pages) - activity indicator replaced with voting button.

However, during the alpha/beta stage clicking register is going to take the user to a barrier/splash page that requires a invite code/whitelisted email address in-order to proceed.

If the user has an invite code/whitelisted email address they can then either register using RPX or using the local registration form. I suppose we could use a modal box at this point rather than using a separate page for local registration?

I think the facebook/twitter registration still needs to be done though.

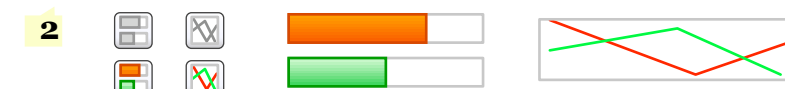
